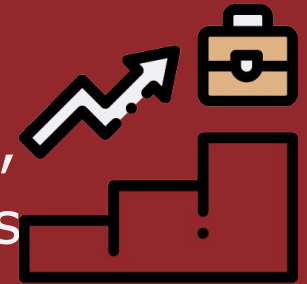


Who CAEL Is

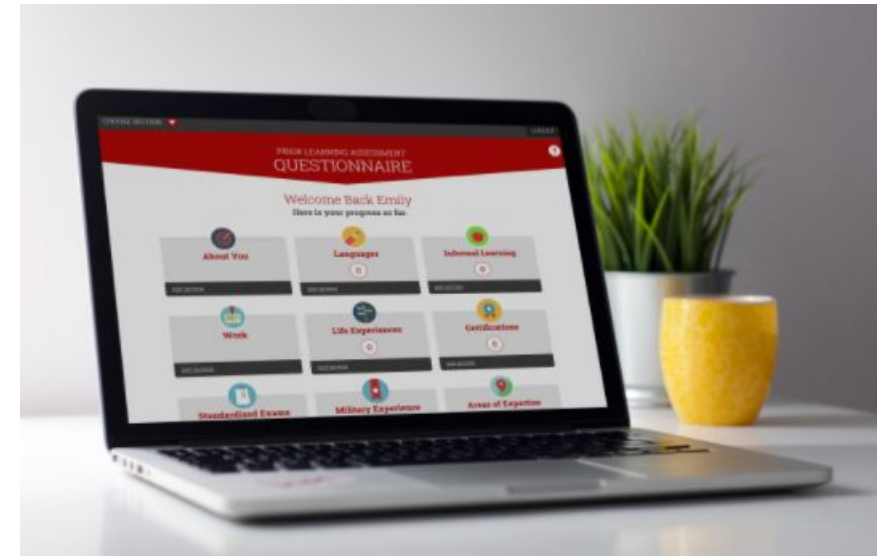
